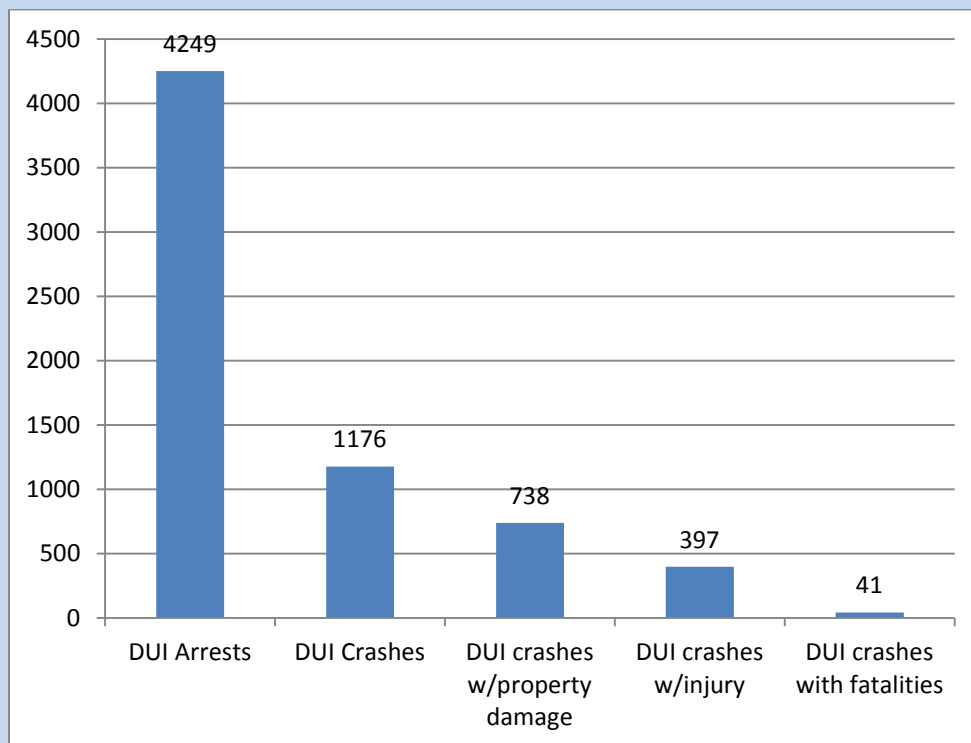

## 2013 DUI's in Delaware

While the most prominent impact of driving under the influence (DUI) is fatalities, fatalities occur in only 3.5% of DUI crashes. There are significant consequences associated with non-fatal DUIs. The Delaware Office of Highway Safety notes large numbers of crashes involving injuries and property damage, and even when physical consequences are not a factor, there is the impact of the time and money involved in the police and courts processing 4,249 arrests for DUI in 2013.
