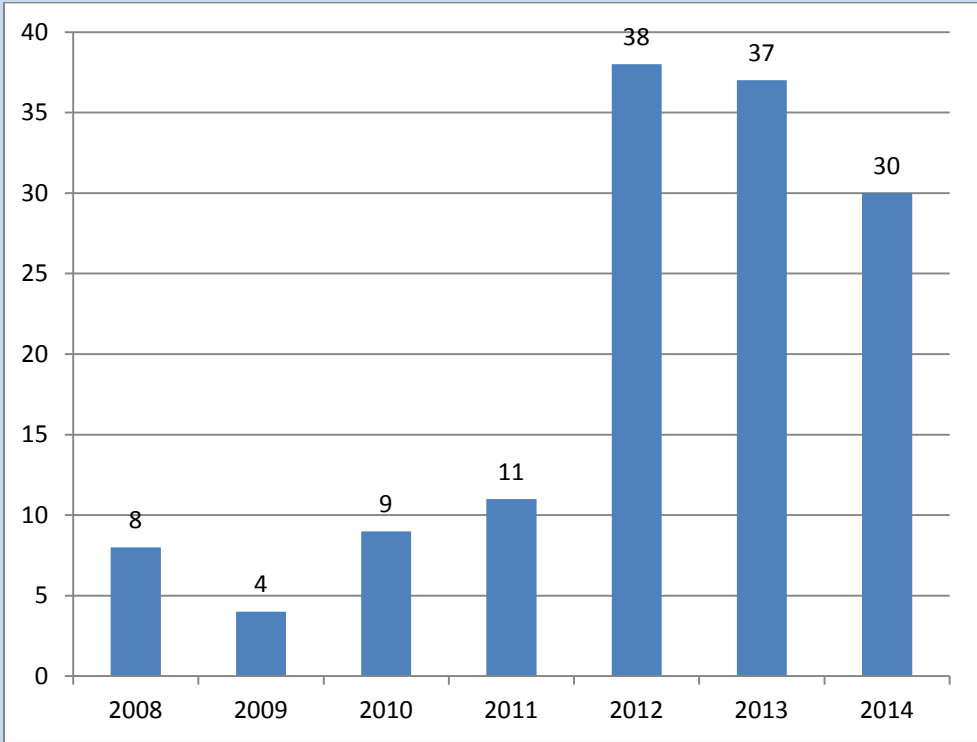




Capacity Building through Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America Increases in Delaware

For most of the twenty-four years that the Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America (CADCA) has been providing training and networking opportunities through its annual national Forum, attendance from Delaware has been minimal. However, with Federal pass-through funding being made accessible through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant and the Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant (both from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, significantly more Delawareans have been able to benefit from the Forum, expand their knowledge and horizons, and attend Capital Hill Day to speak with their Congressmen about Prevention needs and priorities.
